2019 BUCKEYE SALE

The Ohio Dairy Goat Association Buckeye Sale Committee is soliciting nominations for the 2019 Buckeye Sale that will be held in conjunction with the Annual Conference at The Ohio State University, Animal Science Building, in Columbus, Ohio on Saturday evening September 28, 2019. The Buckeye Sale is a unique opportunity to accentuate the accomplishments of your herd. Animals selected are of the highest quality available. The committee will look for animals from herds using official DHIR, linear appraisal and show records. Please keep this in mind when nominating as it ultimately reflects your entire herd, herd management and breeding program.

This sale strives to attract buyers from all over and they want top quality, performance proven, sound and healthy dairy goats. The value of your herd's advertisement and the name recognition it generates can be considerable.

Rest assured that your nomination will receive serious and thorough consideration in our selection process. The Buckeye Sale Committee works very hard to put together a sale that is a successful and positive experience for all parties involved. We all know that quality sells, proven animals, from both sides of a pedigree are needed especially when nominating buck kids.

CAREFULLY read and follow the 2019 Nomination Rules and Regulations and the 2019 Sales Contract. These documents include most of the information needed for nomination and sales process. Nominating your animals is not difficult. We ask for a limited amount (3 pages maximum) of information/photographs about your nominee and its close relatives. The fourth page required is the ADGA Performance Pedigree.

If your nomination is accepted, you will be provided, via email information on displays, brochures, DNA typing and fitting. If you have any additional questions you can contact the Buckeye Sale Committee Chair.

Nomination information must be postmarked by June 1, 2019. Nominations are to be sent to Sue Smart, ODGA President/Buckeye Sale Co-Chair, 8699 State Route 323, Mount Sterling, OH 43143-9415. Nominator should be informed of acceptance decisions on or about June 10, 2019. Consignment fees will be 20% of the sale price and will be deducted from the final sale. NOTE: In rare cases, the ODGA Buckeye Sale Committee will accept late nominations. Please contact Sue Smart about your circumstances and request for a late submission.

It is preferred that the nomination package is in color, but not required. We prefer that the nominator email the packet. Feel free to contact Sue Smart with any questions throughout the nomination process.

RULES and PROCEDURES

Thank you for considering the Ohio Dairy Goat Association Buckeye Sale to assist your dairy goat marketing efforts. We offer the opportunity to promote top quality dairy goats from herds that participate in ADGA production and performance programs, as well as ADGA sanctioned shows. Nominate the very best you have as a representative of your herd breeding and management program.

The nomination packet MUST include:

1. One nominee information/photograph form (8.5" x 11") one side only
2. ADGA Four Generation Performance Pedigree for nominee
3. Maximum of two additional (one side only) 8.5 x 11 pages of supporting information and photographs of nominee and/or its close relative
4. **ONE COPY of the signed consignment contract. Please read it carefully.**

Items to consider when nominating an animal to the Buckeye Sale:

- ❖ All nominees must conform to ADGA Breed Standards, have correct and legible tattoos, be free of physical defects, be sound and healthy, and be tested free of CAE and CL if over 12 months of age. Those under six months of age must have been raised on a CAE prevention program.
- ❖ Virgin bucks and open does are preferred for the sale, but animals under 2 years of age and bred will be considered. Bred does must be accompanied to the sale with a completed service memo.
- ❖ The accepted sale animals are REQUIRED to provide negative test results from a certified laboratory for CAE (only the results of an ELISA test will be accepted) within 30 days of the sale.
- ❖ All animals must be accommodated with a CERTIFIED Veterinarian Health Certificate within 30 days of the date of the sale. This is required for animals being transported into and out of the state of Ohio.

A clear, concise, well-organized presentation will aid your chances of getting your nominee accepted to the sale. The following tips should help you in preparing your nomination packet.

1. TYPED nomination forms are preferred. You can easily type your nominations information and insert pictures onto the Word version of the contract and print it right from your computer.
2. Give the committee the FACTS on your nominee and its relative. Official production records, linear appraisal scores and official show wins help!
3. Identify pictures of relative of the nominee and indicate their relationship to the nominee (i.e., maternal grand dam or paternal half-sister, etc.)
4. Make sure any pictures you use are the best you have available – nothing less than you would put in an ad to market your herd. We suggest using a color copier or getting copies made of one of the kind photographs to avoid losing important materials or photos. Many buyers appreciate being able to keep the display boards used to represent the consignment after the sale.
5. Give thought to the hold prices you indicate in your packet – high hold prices may adversely affect acceptance into the sale.
6. Consignors shall not use photographs for the marketing/advertising of their animals in the Buckeye Sale that are the property of other breeders without their express written permission. Neither the Buckeye Sale Committee nor ODGA shall be held responsible if the consignor fails to secure said permission.

Nomination packets become the property of the ODGA Buckeye Sale Committee.

Hereinafter referred to as the consignor. The consignor, in accordance with the nomination rules and procedures and terms of this contract, agree to consign the _____BUCK _____Doe known as

To the ODGA Buckeye Sale in Columbus, Ohio on Saturday, September 28, 2019. Time will be announced.

- ✓ The consignor may place a hold price on the consignment below which the goat will not be sold. The hold price cannot be raised once the animal is nominated. The consignor retains ownership if the bid does not reach the specified hold price.
- ✓ Within 30 days of the sale, ODGA will send to each consignor the sale price less the 20% commission and less any account payable due to ODGA.
- ✓ Consignment must conform to ADGA Breed Standards, have correct and legible tattoos, be free of physical defects, and be sound and healthy. Otherwise, the consignment will be returned to the consignor at the consignor's cost and the consignment fee forfeited to ODGA. Consignments are expected to be raised and managed on a CAE prevention control program.
- ✓ Consignments must arrive at the Sale location (at the consignor's expense) no earlier than Friday NOON and no later than 9AM Saturday.
- ✓ Each consignor shall provide, at ARRIVAL, an interstate health certificate, ADGA registration certificate, selling displays and brochures, DNA typing results (if typing as been completed) and ADGA Collection forms if applicable, as well as any updated show or performance information since the time of nomination. The health certificate must show the animal to have been negative for CAE & CL testing within 30 days of the sale date if age appropriate.
- ✓ It is suggest for the health of the consignment during and after the sale, the animal should have at least one-half inch or more of hair coat at the time of the sale. A full body clip, with a number 5 blade no later than September 1, 2019. A committee approved fitter will make any necessary adjustments after arrival if necessary. Hooves are to be properly trimmed before arriving at the sale.
- ✓ ODGA and The Ohio State University provide housing pens with bedding. All consignors are required to see that hayracks, hay, grain, water, feeding and water containers are provided throughout the nominees stay on the grounds.
- ✓ Experienced handlers and readers are available to handle the sale animals unless you state in writing that you will be providing your own handler and present/reader.
- ✓ The ODGA Buckeye Sale committee representative and an assigned veterinarian will examine the goats upon arrival, throughout their stay, and will issue interstate health papers for exit. All other veterinary cost is the financial responsibility of the consignor.
- ✓ ODGA agrees to feature the accepted consignment in the official Buckeye Sale brochure and other advertising prior to the sale.
- ✓ ODGA provides reasonable safeguards for the health and safety of the consignments. However, responsibility of the animal and risk or loss, injury or death to the animals remains the consignor's until the consignment sells.

- ✓ Substitution of a nominee/consignment because of death, sickness, or injury may be approved after presentation of the fact to the ODGA Sale Chair. ODGA will not accept a substitute that is deemed of lesser quality than the original nominee.
- ✓ The ODGA Buckeye Sale Chair decides the sale order after consulting with the members (in attendance) of the Buckeye Sale Committee. Lot number does not equal sale order. Sale order is released at approximately NOON the day of the sale. The committee shall decide how the sale order information is to be announced.
- ✓ This contract becomes effective upon the acceptance of the nominee by the ODGA Buckeye Sale Committee, the return of this Signed contract by the nominee along with the payment of a \$25.00 non-refundable consignment fee.
